**Sussex Wantage Pool Rules & Regulations**

1. Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
2. Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages shall be denied admission.
3. Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
4. All children in diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out soiled diapers in the bathing water.
5. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard.
6. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming pool, wading pool, hot tub, or spa area, dressing rooms, or other parts of the enclosure.
7. Glass containers shall be prohibited in food and drink areas.
8. All persons shall shower before entering the water.
9. Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited.
10. Outdoor bathing shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
11. Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water. Alcohol is prohibited.
12. Bathers must be wearing appropriate bathing attire; no street clothes, cutoffs, etc. in the pool.
13. No Running.
14. Rough play or boisterous behavior is not permitted.
15. Diving is permitted from the deep wall (by starting blocks) only, at the discretion of the lifeguard(s). Diving may be restricted during busy times. Use of the starting blocks are intended for swim team use only, under the direct supervision of a swim coach.
16. No child under the age of 14 shall be permitted without a responsible adult (minimum age 18 years old).
17. The Kiddy Pool is intended for young children 8 years old & younger.
18. Children using the kiddy pool must be closely supervised by a parent or responsible adult (minimum age 18 years old).
19. No jumping or diving in the Kiddy Pool.
20. Food and drink are permitted in the grassy areas only.
21. Smoking is permitted in the grassy areas only.
22. Patrons are asked to clean up after themselves, and place all refuse in the appropriate containers.
23. Flotation Devices are permitted under the following conditions:
  - a. The pool is not too crowded that they pose a safety and/or visibility concern. This is up to the discretion of the lifeguard.

- b. Flotation devices must be used safely, and may not be excessive in size.
  - c. Non-swimmers using flotation device(s) may not bathe in water that exceeds their ability to stand, unless when a child is accompanied by a parent/responsible adult within close proximity. This adult must be a competent swimmer.
  - d. The lifeguard(s) may revoke the use of flotation devices at any time as they deem necessary.
24. Lifeguards have the responsibility and authority to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment.
25. Abiding by all of these Swim Club Rules & Regulations and cooperating with all Swim Club personnel is a non-negotiable condition of membership. Any patron who refuses to comply may be asked to leave for the day, have their membership suspended, or have their membership revoked. There are no refunds.
