Mr. Lange asked if the fields at Lott Road could be dragged ( in the Spring) on Thursday or Friday as they are done at Woodbourne. By having the fields dragged the clay stays softer, so the children are less prone to injury when they slide.

Mr. Lange requested additional fencing at Woodbourne field #4 along the first and third base line. He explained the bleachers are no longer behind protective fencing. Mrs. Feoranzo made the motion to approve an eight foot by fifty foot fence. Mrs. Cary seconded the motion. Ayes: Card, Carey, Cary, Feoranzo, Merritt, Williams, Armstrong. Nays: None. Absent: Baig. The Commission agreed if there are any additional funds in the budget, Recreation will help with the funding.

Mr. Lange also let the Commission know that in the Spring, the large baseball field in Sussex will be a small field. His concern is a field shortage, and too many traveling teams with players from other towns. He explained teams are using field #4 at Woodbourne and the teams have not requested field time. The Commission thanked Mr. Lange for the information.
