A leak in an above ground oil tank on Crigger Road was discovered before it contaminated the soil.

Neighbors of 125 Coykendall Road have been complaining of a foul odor. Upon inspection chickens are being raised for sale to restaurants. The flock is regulated by the County Agriculture Committee. The farm is also protected under the Right to Farm Act. The investigation is ongoing with the Health Department and Wantage Zoning Department.

John Maione is interested in opening a Cigar Bar at the Wantage Town Center. It is no longer legal to open a cigar bar in NJ.
