The septic issue previously discussed at 173 Mudtown Road is now being handled by the DEP.

The first Soil Air Remediation in a septic system in Wantage Township has been installed in a home on Greenville Road. The new technique is ninety five percent effective in bringing a sluggish system back to use. Remediation not Alteration are printed on the permits the County issues.. Quick Chek has a similar system added as a precaution to a new system.

Mobile vendor, Don's Hot Dogs has been approved to operate.

The Health department is awaiting Dollars and Cents'; located in the A&P Plaza, food plan review, after approval, a Food Handler's License will be issued.
