The chicken farm located at 125 Coykendall Road has removed most of the animals and cleaned the barn. The DEP has issued a Notice of Violation for the installation of an illegal septic system for the barns. The systems must be removed in the presence of a Health Department official. Both the zoning officer and the health department have been involved with the removal of the chickens over concerns regarding wetlands pollution. The County Health Department continues to monitor the public non community wells. The State is investigating these wells with a PNCW questionnaire. There has been an ongoing active investigation and enforcement regarding the illegal dumping in the property located at 16 Lewisburg Road.
