## TOWNSHIP OF WANTAGE RESOLUTION EXTENDING A MORATORIUM OF THE ISSUANCE OF ZONING PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF OUTDOOR WOODBURNING STOVES/FURNACES

**WHEREAS**, on November 10, 2011, the Wantage Township committee introduced an ordinance which will regulate the use of outdoor wood burning stoves/furnaces, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wantage that the above-referenced moratorium is extended up until the publication of the public notice of final adoption for Ordinance 2011-16, or until the date of December 31, 2011, whichever occurs first.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Wantage that to the extent that any law, ordinance, rule or regulation is in conflict with the provisions of the resolution, this resolution shall control.
