**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WANTAGE ACCEPTING THE STREET KNOWN AS
DUNN PLACE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wantage, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The following street has been dedicated to the Township of Wantage by the making and filing of maps and is hereby accepted as a public street:

Dunn Place, as approved by Resolution of the Wantage Township Planning Board on October 25, 2001, Planning Board Application No. 18-01 and as shown on filed map No. 1311 filed in the Sussex County Clerk's Office on January 15, 2002.

2. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of the adoption of this Ordinance as provided by law and to file a certified copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the Sussex County Clerk as provided by law.

4. This Ordinance shall take effect after publication and passage according to law.
