

**WANTAGE TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE #13-2024**

**ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$244,347.00 FOR VARIOUS ACQUISITIONS
AND IMPROVEMENTS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WANTAGE**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Wantage, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: The capital improvements described in Section 3 of this capital ordinance are hereby authorized as general capital improvements to be undertaken by the Township of Wantage, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey. For the said improvements or purposes stated in Section 3 hereof, there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$244,347.00, said sum being available in the Township's General Capital Fund.

SECTION 2: In connection with the amount authorized in Section 1 hereof, the Township makes the following determinations:

- 1) The purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is a purchase the Township of Wantage may lawfully make as a capital purchase.
- 2) The period of usefulness of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not in the limitation of said Local Bond law and according to the aggregate reasonable life thereof is five (5) years or longer.

SECTION 3: The improvements and purposes hereby authorized are for:

- 1) Acquisition of Kohler 10kW Propane Generator and Above Ground Propane Tank
- 2) Improvements to Township Fuel Dispensing
- 3) Various Roadway Improvements

SECTION 4: This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon publication after adoption.
